

The Concept

Grammar is often taught well, but quickly forgotten.

Easy Education Grammar provides a structured retention model that sits alongside your existing English provision, helping pupils retain, strengthen and apply their grammar knowledge.

The aim is simple: reduce repeated reteaching and strengthen sentence-level writing.

How The Model Works

Core Grammar Teaching

New grammar objectives are explicitly taught within your existing English unit.

- Teaching PowerPoints
- Modelling and guided examples
- Initial application

This introduces the skill.

Individual schools determine how grammar objectives align with their existing English units.

Retention System

Daily Retrieval

Short, 5-10 minute starters revisiting previously taught objectives.

- Daily Recap - mixed retrieval across prior objectives
- Back to Basics versions - focused retrieval for pupils consolidating fundamental skills

Regular retrieval helps pupils retain previously taught grammar.

Weekly Retrieval

Short weekly activities that revisit key areas of grammar and punctuation.

- Mend It Monday: focuses on year-group-appropriate punctuation
- Tense Tuesday: strengthens understanding of tense through consistent retrieval
- Word Wednesday: deepens understanding of word classes
- Weekly Focus: a short, more formal retrieval task used to assess understanding where needed

These strengthen key areas through regular revisiting and provide opportunities to monitor progress.

Targeted & General Practice

Application tasks are used once objectives have been taught or revisited.

- Targeted practice – reinforcement of a specific objective
- General practice – broader consolidation

These activities provide further practice with objectives that pupils need to revisit.

Sentence-Level Writing

Writing lessons that help pupils develop their sentences and make purposeful grammar choices.

- Sentence-level improvement
- Grammar for effect
- Deliberate sentence variation and structure

This helps pupils apply grammar and sentence techniques more confidently within extended writing. It also supports pupils in shaping their writing for purpose and voice, including writing to persuade, inform, discuss and entertain.
